



BUSINESS VISA REQUIREMENTS

The Business visa is intended for applicants who are businessmen going to visit customers, do marketing research, attend business meetings, potential buyers or investors invited by Argentinean companies.

Documents to Present:

1. One set of Visa Application Form (Original) dated & signed by the applicant (preferably filled by computer)
2. Sworn Statement dated & signed
3. Two recent photographs 4x4 cm with White background (put in an envelope - DO NOT PASTE).
4. Photocopy (on A4 paper only) of Valid Passport (first & second page) including valid visas.
5. Company's bank statements for the last 06 months certified by the bank (with name stamp of bank officer).
6. Round Trip Flight Itinerary: Ticket, E-Ticket or Flight booking.
7. Hotel Booking or accommodation arrangements (must be corresponding with Visa Application Form & Flight)
8. Recommendation Letter from the relevant Chamber of Commerce & Industry.
9. Personal Note from the applicant explaining the reasons of trip.
10. International Health Insurance.
11. **(Only for applicants who are employed by the company)** Letter of introduction of the applicant, with designation & salary details, by the company in Pakistan/Afghanistan/Tajikistan requesting the visa and stating purpose of the trip, length of stay and level of financial support over the applicant.
12. **(Only for applicants who are owners/proprietors of the company)** Evidence of the company's activities and ownership with the applicant (e.g. invoices, tax record, Company house certificate, articles of association, etc).
13. **Invitation Letter from a businessman or company in Argentina**, Letter of invitation from the company in Argentina stating; personal data of the applicant (complete passport details), purpose of the trip, length of stay, level of financial support (if any) over the applicant and full details of the organization or person. **Invitation must be submitted in original to the Embassy or to the Applicant at least 45 days before trip.** The signature of the signing person must be certified by an Argentine notary public and subsequently by Colegio de Escribanos. The company must be registered at Registro Nacional Unico de Requirientes Extranjeros (RENURE) and must provide their registration number written on the first page of invitation (<http://www.migraciones.gov.ar/accesible/indexA.php?requirientes>). Scanned copy of invitation letter is acceptable just to start visa process but business visa will only be issued (if granted) upon the reception of original invitation letter.
14. Consular Section Staff can request additional documents or information in order to complete visa application before or after interview.

Application Submission: Applications (without original passport) are submitted via our Drop-Box service provider, **FedEx** (Gerry's International, Tel: 111 711 111). The Consular Section of the Argentine Embassy does not receive/deliver passports by Drop-Box or mail.

Visa Interview: All visa applicants shall be interviewed by the Head of the Consular Section in Islamabad. Interview shall be scheduled via email within 7 working days after submission of complete visa application at Drop-Box. Applicants are interviewed only if all required documents are provided, otherwise the applications shall be denied on presentation. **Invitation letters must be submitted in original to the applicant or Embassy at least 45 days before trip.**

Visa Fee: When informed about the acceptance of the visa application and relevant documents for visa processing, the applicant have to deposit the visa processing fee, 200 USD in Habib Bank Limited, F-6 Islamabad. The fee deposit slip will be issued by the Embassy.

Note: The visa processing fee is nonrefundable; it is only for initiating the visa process. It is neither dependent upon the results of the visa request nor it guarantees a positive outcome.
